# PRIORITY TRADE ISSUES (PTI)

- Priority Trade Issues (PTIs) represent high-risk areas that can cause significant revenue loss, harm the U.S. economy, or threaten the health and safety of the American people. They can include:
  - Agriculture and Quota
    - Import Safety
  - Intellectual Property Rights
    - Revenue
  - Textiles/Wearing Apparel
    - Trade Agreements
  - **Antidumping and Countervailing**

# Introduction – What is AD/CVD?

- AD/CVD duties are trade remedies which level the playing field for U.S. manufacturers against unfair foreign competition
- Antidumping duties remedy imports sold at unfair low prices
- Countervailing duties remedy imports which benefit from foreign government subsidies

# What is AD/CVD?

## Case Number Identification

A-570-970-001  
C-570-971-002

- A=Antidumping, C=Countervailing

- 570=country code(China)

- 970, 971 = commodity code(wood flooring)

- 001, 002.. = specific company code (manufacturer/exporter)

- 000 = “all others”

# The Players

- **The U.S. Department of Commerce is the administering authority for AD/CVD(International Trade Administration(ITA) is a unit within DOC):**
  - ❖ **Determines imports of less than fair value and subsidization**
  - ❖ **General administration of AD/CVD laws and determines rates**
- **The International Trade Commission(ITC)[Independent Federal Agency]:**
  - ❖ **Determines injury to US industry**
- **Customs and Border Protection (CBP):**
  - ❖ **Collects AD/CVD Duties**
  - ❖ **Administers AD/CVD Entries**

# IMPORTING COMMUNITY RESPONSIBILITIES

Importers and their authorized agents are responsible for:

**a. Monitoring the Federal Register for the status of AD/CVD investigations** and entering the subject merchandise in accordance with the published case information;

**b. Filing entries of the subject merchandise with the correct AD/CVD entry type code.** The appropriate entry type codes for AD/CVD entries are listed below:

Entry Type	Description
03	Consumption: Antidumping and/or Countervailing Duties
06	Consumption: Foreign Trade Zone
07	Consumption: Antidumping and/or Countervailing Duties and Quota/Visa
34	Warehouse Withdrawal: Antidumping and/or Countervailing Duties
38	Warehouse Withdrawal: Antidumping and/or Countervailing Duties and Quota/Visa

# IMPORTING COMMUNITY RESPONSIBILITIES

**c. Filing entry summaries of the subject merchandise under the correct AD/CVD case number(s) and cash deposit rate(s)** for the manufacturer(s) and/or exporter(s) identified by DOC.


- i. These requirements are in addition to all other entry requirements; and,
- ii. ACE will automatically calculate the AD/CVD cash deposit amounts based on inputted case/rate.

**d. Submitting a new continuous bond** when there is a significant change in the AD/CVD duties, taxes, and fees, or in the nature or value of the cargo since the original bond was approved.


**e. Complete a non-reimbursement certificate/statement**, signed by an officer of the importing company. Upload to ACE or provide to CBP as requested.

- i. Importers and their authorized agents have a responsibility to inform CBP if they receive any reimbursement of AD after filing the reimbursement certificates/statements.
- ii. Reimbursement certificates/statements are required for AD cases and may be required for a CVD case when an AD and CVD case apply to the same line. DOC will indicate in final liquidation instructions when this rule applies.




# Anti-Dumping Timeline












